

Stock Apps Subscription Control

Transparent subscription setting for Admin users

This guide explains the Subscription section in Admin Setting. The purpose is to manage customer subscription status in a clear and professional way. The app does not hide artificial SQL delays or make the system intentionally slow.

Recommended Business Behavior

Free, Trial, and Paid customers can continue using the app normally.

Expired customers see a clear notice and cannot create, print, edit, delete, or scan transaction items.

Read-only screens such as Stock Balance and Sales Dashboard remain viewable so customers can still access business information.

Grace Days gives the customer a small buffer after the expiry date before full features are blocked.

Subscription Status

Status	Meaning	App Behavior
Free	Initial free use for customer evaluation.	Full app remains usable. Notice shows Free Plan.
Trial	Temporary subscription before customer commits.	Full app remains usable until expiry plus grace days.
Paid	Customer has active paid subscription.	Full app remains usable until expiry plus grace days.
Expired	Subscription is no longer active.	Write and print actions are blocked with a clear message.

Admin Setting Fields

Field	Description	Example
Company Code	A short code that identifies which customer or company owns this Stock Apps subscription.	SPHL, ABC001, CUSTOMER01
License Key	A license or subscription reference issued by you. At this stage it is stored as a control and record value.	SCR-SPHL-2026-001
Grace Days	Extra allowed days after the expiry date before the app blocks create, print, edit, delete, and scan transaction actions.	3

Grace Days Example

If Expiry Date is **31/07/2026** and Grace Days is **3**, the customer can continue using full features until **03/08/2026**. On **04/08/2026**, the app becomes expired mode unless the subscription is renewed.

What Expired Mode Blocks

Create new Stock Take, Cash Bill, Sales Invoice, and Sales Order documents.

Scan or add transaction items.

Edit header information or item lines.

Delete item lines.

Print Cash Bill, Sales Invoice, or Sales Order documents.

What Remains Viewable

Stock Balance lookup.

Sales Dashboard viewing.

Existing document lists and information screens.

Settings page, so Admin can update the subscription after payment.

Suggested Admin Workflow

Step	Scenario	Action
1	New customer	Set Status = Free. Leave Expiry Date blank or set a trial date if needed.
2	Customer evaluating	Set Status = Trial and enter Expiry Date.
3	Customer paid	Set Status = Paid, enter Expiry Date, Company Code, and License Key.
4	Payment overdue	Set Status = Expired, or let expiry plus grace days automatically expire.

Professional Principle

Keep subscription control transparent. Customers should understand why a feature is blocked and how to restore it. Avoid hidden performance delays because they can damage trust and make the software appear unstable.
